Austria



Viennese Iced Coffee

One of the many coffee specialties in Vienna is an Iced Coffee which is popular during summer. The McDonald's Austria version is made from espresso and sundae ice-cream, topped with chocolate chips.



Wiener Frühstück

The 'Wiener Frühstück' is the classic and very popular Viennese breakfast made up of coffee, a choice of two pastries or bread, accompanied by butter, jam and honey.

Czech Republic & Slovakia



McCountry

A hearty burger made using two pork patties. Pork is extremely popular in Slovakia and the Czech Republic, making up 50% of all meat consumed.

Denmark



Chicken Salsa Cheese

A chicken sandwich with cheddar cheese and salsa, launched in response to growing appetite and demand for chicken products in Denmark.

Finland



Rye McFeast

The 'Ruis McFeast' (Rye McFeast) is an adapted version of the McFeast burger which is popular locally. The Rye McFeast uses typical Finnish rye bread, which is a strong element of Finnish food culture.

France



Croque McDo

Based on the typical French snack the 'Croque Monsieur', the Croque McDo is made from ham and melted emmental cheese, encased in toasted bread.

Germany



Nuremburger

Three traditional Nuremberg sausages topped with crispy fried onions and mustard sauce. The Nuremburger brings together two of Germany's favourite foods: burgers and bratwurst.

Hungary



McFarm

A pork burger introduced in 2001 to cater for Hungarian customers increasingly looking for an alternative to beef.

Italy



McItaly

A burger created exclusively from Italian produce, including Parmigiano-Reggiano, Speck dell'Alto Adige and pancetta from the Val Venosta.



280gr Parmigiano Reggiano Burger

A premium burger using top quality, typical Italian cheese.

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Morocco



McArabia

A popular Arabic-themed sandwich available in Morocco and at most McDonald's outlets throughout the Middle East.

Portugal



Soups (Sopíissima)

On the menu in Portugal are six different flavours of traditional recipe soups: Caldo Verde soup (the most typical Portuguese soup), Lavrador Soup (comprising beans, cabbage, carrot, ham and noodles), Vegetable Soup, White Bean Soup, Spinach Cream Soup and Carrot Soup. Portugal has one of the highest levels of soup consumption in the world.

Russia



Beef a la Russ

A beef sandwich using rye bread which is popular in Russia.

Spain



Capricho Manchego

A Spanish style chicken wrap with Manchego cheese sauce.



Gazpacho Soup

A typical Spanish vegetable soup, served cold.

Sweden



Frukostmackan

There are two versions of the Frukostmackan: the original is made with ham and typical Swedish cheese. The more recent version features cream cheese and turkey.

The Netherlands



McKroket

A sandwich with a deep-fried patty containing beef ragout with a breadcrumb coating, which is similar to the popular Dutch 'Croquette' sold in local snack bars.

United Kingdom



Porridge with jam

Oatso Simple porridge served with strawberry jam or syrup. Porridge has long been a staple of the traditional English breakfast.
